- BMW Charity Pro-Am Golf Tournament - A popular event located at Thornblade Country Club

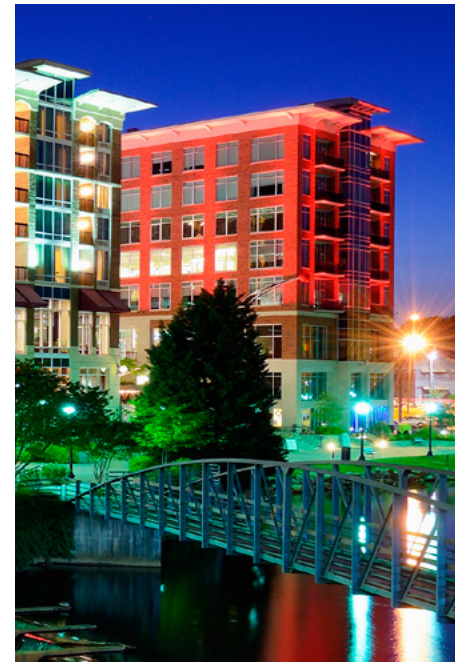
Arts and Entertainment
