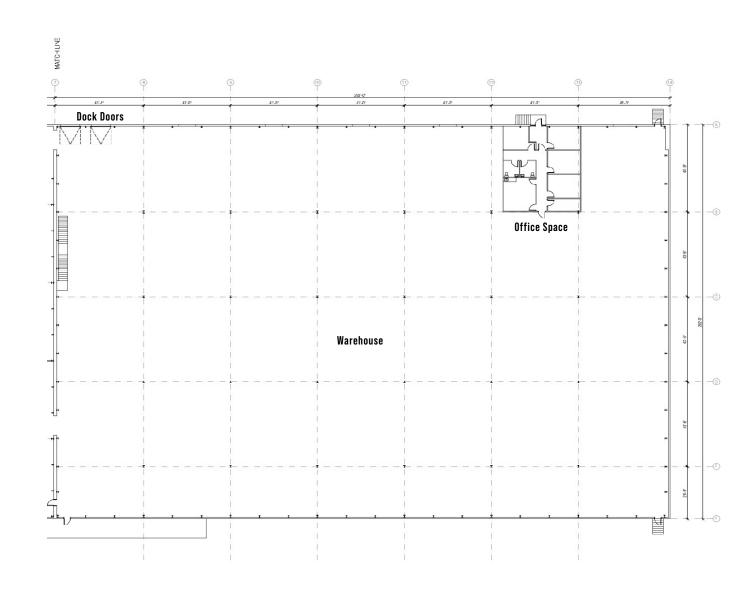
Floor Plan

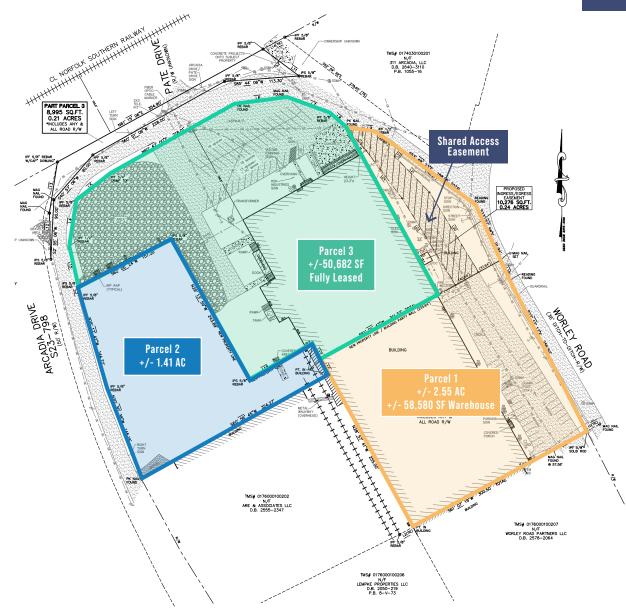

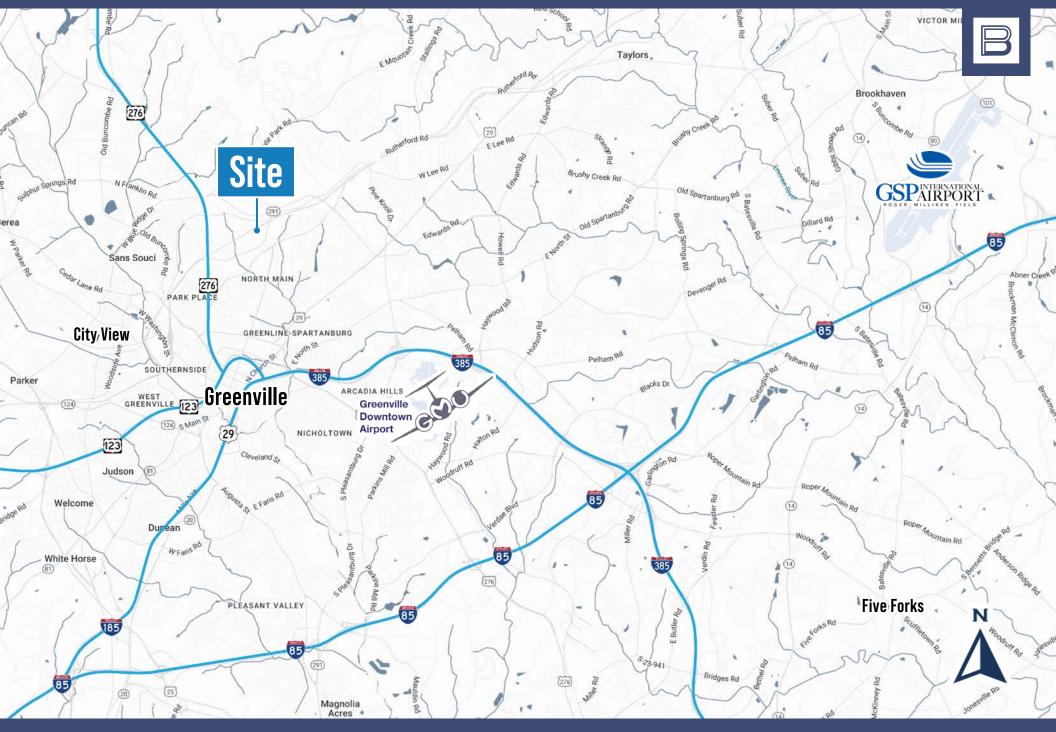


















72,926 POPULATION3-Mile Radius
